Polycystic ovarian syndrome (PCOS) is the most prevailing female hormonal disorder and one of the major causes of infertility in India , incidence being around 10 % . Lack of knowledge about the condition , misconceptions and faulty lifestyle contributes to significant suffering and poor quality of life in women.

The PCOS society of India has launched the programme "Vijayeta" which is an initiative to create awareness among adolescent girls and women regarding this condition. in collaboration with radio Mirchi this involves a series of 8 interviews with eminent gynaecologists which are being broadcasted over a period of 1 month as well as outreach activities in schools, colleges and corporate offices in your city. In Pondicherry, the department of Gynaecology , Mahatma Gandhi Medical College and Research Institute is collaborating with PCOS society of India and radio Mirchi providing the professional expertise.
